We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, Maths and English homework that are set.

<p><b>History - Tudors</b></p> <p>Create your own wall painting (on paper) of Henry VIII.</p> 	<p><b>Science - Cycles in Nature</b></p> <p>Make a fact-file or poster about the life cycle of your favourite plant.</p>	<p><b>Geography - Spatial Sense</b></p> <p>Draw a map of your local area. You could include your route to school, parks, beaches, woods etc</p>
<p><b>RE - Buddhism: Is it possible for everyone to be happy?</b></p> <p>Create your own story about someone who has no money but is very happy and another character that has lots of money but is never happy. Why is this? This could be handwritten, typed on a computer, illustrated or even a comic strip!</p>	<p><b>Art - Monuments of Byzantine</b></p> <p>Use symmetry to create a mosaic out of scrap paper at home.</p> 	<p><b>PSHE/Computing</b></p> <p>Make a factfile about yourself - handwritten or use ICT</p>
