We would like children to select at least one of the homework challenges below for this term, however children can do as many as they wish. This will continue to be run alongside the regular reading, Maths and English homework that are set.

<p>History - Crime and Punishment</p> <p>Rules Then and Now (Writing)</p> <p>Rules help keep everyone safe and happy. Pick one of these body systems or parts and create a small fact file about it on a piece of paper.</p> <p>Choose one:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Skeleton/Bones 2. Muscles 🦵 3. Heart & Blood ❤️ 4. Brain 🧠 5. Lungs 	<p>Geography - Mediterranean Europe</p> <p>Choose ONE to make:</p> <p>Mini Pizzas (or Pittas): Use a pre-made pitta bread, tortilla, or English muffin as a base. Spread on a little tomato sauce, then add "sunshine toppings" like chopped peppers, sliced tomatoes, basil leaves, and a sprinkle of cheese. Bake until golden (with adult help).</p> <p>Greek Salad Skewers: Thread chunks of cucumber, cherry tomatoes, cubes of feta cheese, and black olives onto a small stick or skewer. Drizzle a tiny bit of olive oil over them.</p> <p>Hummus Dippers: Prepare some ready-made hummus (or use a simple recipe). Slice up sticks of carrot, cucumber, and bell peppers for dipping.</p>
<p>RE - The Christmas Story</p> <p>Create a storyboard for the nativity story.</p> 	<p>Art - Take One Picture</p> <p>Create a unique piece of artwork using paint, coloured pencils, chalks, pastels... anything you have at home!</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Learn your 6 and 7 times table until you know them off by heart and can recite them in class.</p>
