

## Catch Up Funding Spring 1 Update – Louise Jackson

## Heacham Infant and Junior, Snettisham Primary

Allocation per school

HJS - £10,960

HIS - £6,080

SPS - £7,860

Tier 1 – Quality First Teaching – target spend March 21= 50%

- Transition events in Sept, CPD sessions on Maths, English for NQT, RQT and TA (Impact =staff including TAS delivering KRC throughout pandemic in line with policies)
- Moderation meetings YR-Y6, subject leader time Foundation Subjects (Impact= shared understanding of high expectations in each year group)

Tier 2- Targeted Academic Support – target spend March 21 = 50%

- Three groups of pupils per school receiving National Tutoring in reading starting Feb 21 (Impact= reaching those 10% who find it hard to engage)
- Use of gap analysis tool to teach to pupil gaps (pixl/maths UK) (Impact = tch continuing our assessment procedures to help pupil stay on track – no loss in momentum through a separate recovery curriculum – data evidences growth)
- Teachers teaching to gaps in booster classes for English, Language, Phonics, and Maths (SPS/HJS/HIS)
  (Impact= Y2 phonics at/above NA at SPS and HIS, Y6 shows improved data in key year groups since 2019)

Tier 3 – Wider Strategies – target spend March 21= 50%

• Lego therapy nurture delivered Autumn 20 for those with trauma and SEMH

(impact = key vulnerable SEND/SEMH showing excellent progress with inclusion, communication)

• Classdojo set up as remote learning platform and used across schools since Sept 20 for bubble closure and lockdown.

(Impact= facilitated daily feedback, engagement close to 90% now, parent feedback is good, community zooms to help families teach and engage)
