UK PARLIAMENT VISIT, LONDON - 8 JANUARY 2024

We are pleased to tell you that a curriculum trip, together with Snettisham Primary, has been arranged for Year 6 to visit UK Parliament in London.

<u>Details</u>: The departure time from school will be **8.00am so children will need to be in class at 7.50am please**. They will get back to school at approximately **8.30pm**.
