OUR LEARNING

Year 3/4 Oystercatcher

This half term we have been enjoying the warmer weather and having a wonderful time learning how to swim at the Oasis swimming pool! We have had art lessons outside painting, we have been making electrical circuits in science and we have even tried some Roman cuisine in our Latin lessons! We have learnt about count-controlled loops in computing and in History we have been exploring how much leisure and entertainment has changed since the 1900s. This summer half term has been incredibly exciting, consisting of circuit building, painting, animating and learning how to protect our planet. Year 5 – Albatross

This half term, Year 5 have enjoyed a busy and exciting range of learning across the curriculum. In Design and Technology, the children designed and created their own moving toys, exploring different mechanisms and developing their problem-solving and teamwork skills. In Science, we have been learning about life cycles, investigating how animals and plants grow and change over time. Our Geography lessons have taken us all the way to New Zealand, where the class explored its physical features, culture and location in the world. In RE, the children have been learning about Hinduism, gaining an understanding of key beliefs, traditions and celebrations. We are very proud of the enthusiasm and creativity the children have shown throughout the half term.



Year 6 – Royal Tern

It has of course been a very important half-term for Year 6 with their SATS taking place, it's safe to say that they absolutely gave it their all. Not just in SATs week but throughout the year in preparation to demonstrate just how clever, bright and amazing they all are. We've also been busy immersing ourselves in Shakespeare tales – namely Macbeth and Romeo and Juliet. We have enjoyed reading about these stories and creating our own versions of them! In Science we learned about the human body and its different systems, while in Art we studied the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood, with some pupils volunteering themselves to dress as one of the subjects in a painting! We've thoroughly enjoyed dodgeball, it's a very competitive game for our class. In the classroom we have been really invested in our topic of The Cold War in history, which continues to be a favourite subject for many of the pupils. We did manage to get out and adventure to 'Crucial Crew' at the end of April, which provided the pupils with vital life skills such as CPR, what to do in the event of a gas leak and precautions to take to prevent fires!

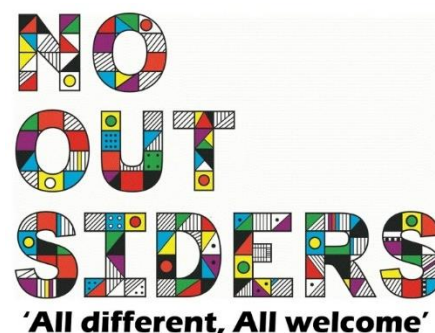

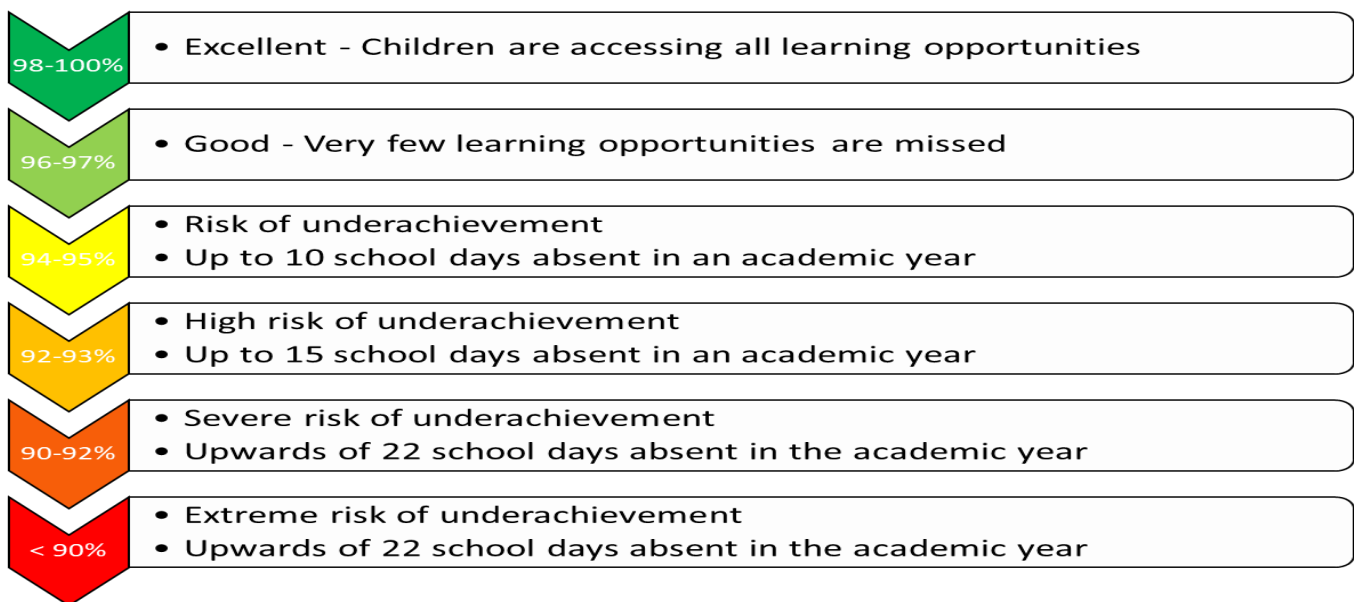


THE IMPORTANCE OF GOOD ATTENDANCE

We want every child to enjoy school and achieve their potential in education and life beyond. We are always here to talk through any issues and help find solutions. Parents are always a phone call away if a child is too ill to continue their day, please encourage them to try to give the day a go, children often feel much better once they are in class.

The Government has issued new attendance guidance and targets to all schools, you may receive regular texts informing you of the number of days that your child has been absent in a term/year.
